<p><u>English:</u> In English, we will be developing our writing skills by reading a range of different texts, both fiction and non-fiction.</p>	<p><u>Maths:</u> Year 6 – SATs revision. Money Project Year 5- Getting ready for Year 6</p>	
<p><u>History:</u> During this unit, we will be exploring the Greek Senate and how the UK has adopted their democratic way of governing countries. We will explore the similarities and differences between our government and theirs. We will also be looking at the Ancient Greek Civilisation and what life was like during this period. We will be looking at Greek Myths and religious ideas and the impact they had on the lives of the Greeks.</p>	<p><u>Science:</u> Year 6 – <i>Controlling Electrical Circuits</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Batteries are a store of energy. This energy pushes electricity round the circuit. When the battery's energy is gone it stops pushing. Voltage measures the 'push'. Current is how much electricity is flowing round a circuit. The greater the current flowing through a device the harder it works. When current flows through wires heat is released. The greater the current the more heat is released <p>Year 5 – <i>Animals; Respiration</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oxygen is breathed into the lungs where it is absorbed by the blood. The heart pumps blood around the body. Muscles need oxygen to release the energy from food to do work: Oxygen is taken into the blood in the lungs, the heart pumps blood through blood vessels to the muscles, the muscles take the oxygen and nutrients from the blood <p><u>DT:</u> N/A</p>	
<p><u>Computing:</u> We will be enhancing our programming (and Robot skills!) during our 'Lego Mindstorms' unit. We will programme, de-bug and create an array of different 'journey's' for our Robot to travel along,</p>	<p><u>Art:</u> In Art, we will be studying Greek Architecture, including influences as well as making comparisons with more modern architecture.
